


#2 Animating Text layers

Add Keyframes


1. On the timeline, extend the beginning of the clip ten frames (or longer if the animation calls for it)
2. Move the playhead to the marker where word is heard in the song.
3. Select the clip in the timeline.
4. In Effect Controls panel click Toggle Animation  (stopwatch symbol to the left of the word Position.)
A keyframe will be created.
5. Move the playhead to the beginning of the clip.
6. In the Program panel – click on the word and drag it off screen. (a keyframe is automatically added in the Effect Controls Panel.)

Nested

1. When you are finished with the lyric page – trim the end of all the clip to end after they have all been heard.
2. Select all the video layers EXCEPT the color matte.
3. Right Click and choose Nest.
4. You can now add keyframes or a Transition to the end of the nested sequence (just like a single clip) so that all the texts move off screen together.

Masking

Add Keyframes:

1. On the timeline, extend the beginning of the clip ten frames (or longer if the animation calls for it)
2. Move the playhead to the marker where word is heard in the song.
3. Select the clip in the timeline.
4. In Effect Controls panel click Toggle Animation  (stopwatch symbol to the left of the word Position.)
A keyframe will be created.
5. Move the playhead to the beginning of the clip.
6. In the Program panel – click on the word to a new position – but it should still be visible on the screen.

Add a Mask

1. Go to the first frame in the clip
2. In the Effect Controls panel – go to the Opacity effect at the top of the panel (between Motion and TimeRemapping)
 - a. NOT the Opacity setting for the Title.
3. Click on the pen tool (be sure to only click the tool ONCE)
4. As you move the Selection tool to the Program monitor the Pen tool will appear.
5. Use the Pen to click corners of a box that surrounds the word – make sure you click the original point to close the mask selection.
6. Then in the Effect Controls panel in the Mask setting -check the box Inverted. The word disappears.
7. Play the video – your word will appear from behind the mask.
